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## INTRODUCTION

The 2007 Illinois Travel Statistics publication is assembled to provide detailed traffic information to the different users of traffic data. While most users of traffic data at this level of detail are within the Illinois Department of Transportation, this publication is distributed outside the Department.

**The 2007 Illinois Travel Statistics publication along with the previous seven years of travel publications can be viewed and downloaded from the IDOT web site [www.dot.il.gov](http://www.dot.il.gov) under the “Traveling Public” selection.**

During 2006, three counties were moved from District 9 to District 7. In 2005, nineteen counties were moved to different Districts as part of IDOT’s overall reorganization plan. Any comparison of District data between years need to take in consideration the new District boundaries.

Annual average daily traffic volumes (AADT) and vehicle miles of travel (VMT) are products of the IDOT’s Traffic Count Program. Counts from this program range in duration from data continuously recorded at permanent count stations to thousands of coverage count locations that are counted for a 24-hour period during the year. More information about IDOT’s Traffic program can be found in the “Illinois Traffic Monitoring Program” document at <http://www.dot.il.gov/itmp.pdf> .

The mileage and vehicle miles of travel data in the following tables are based on roads/streets located within the Districts geographical boundaries (Administrative District). In this report, the State System consists of state maintained highways including highways marked as Interstate, United States or Illinois routes.

Vehicle miles of travel (VMT) are calculated by multiplying the mileage times the AADT from the Illinois Highway Information System. VMT data is expressed as either daily vehicle miles of travel (DVMT) or as annual vehicle miles of travel (AVMT).

The term "urban" applies to those miles that are in incorporated or unincorporated places with 5,000 or greater population. Urban areas may include any adjacent areas that have or are developing urban characteristics. The term "rural" consists of those miles located outside an urban area. An urbanized area, consists of an incorporated place and adjacent densely settled area that together have a minimum population of 50,000.

AADT - Annual Average Daily Traffic

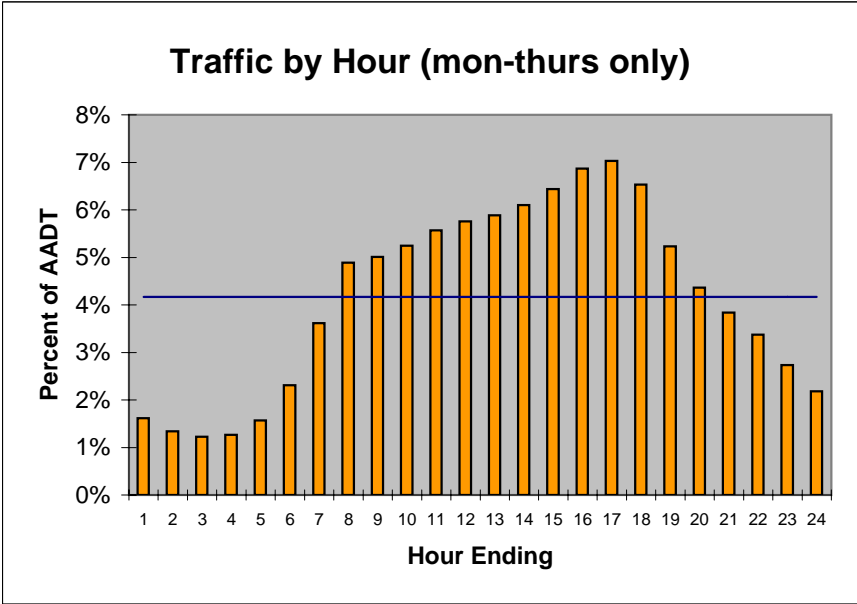
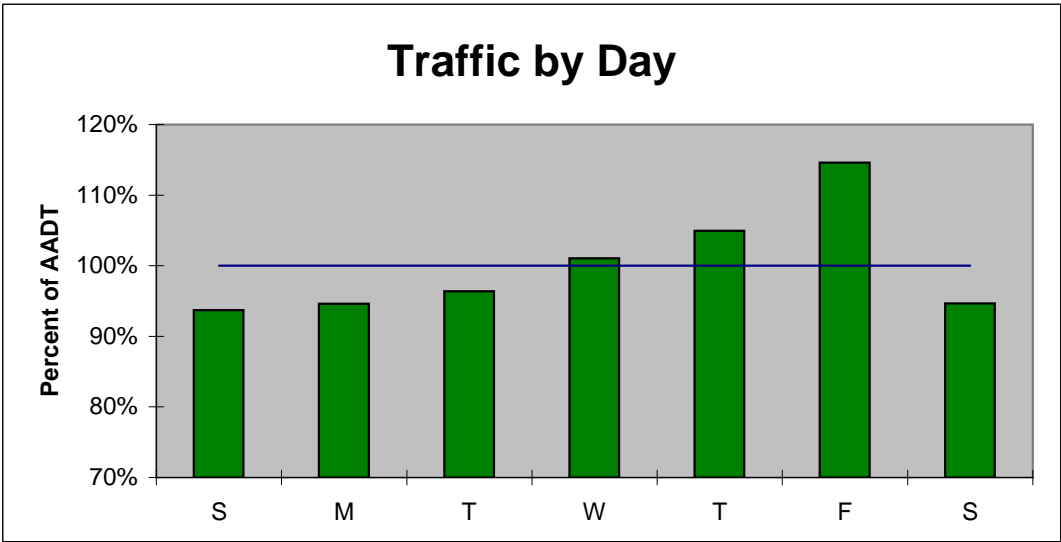
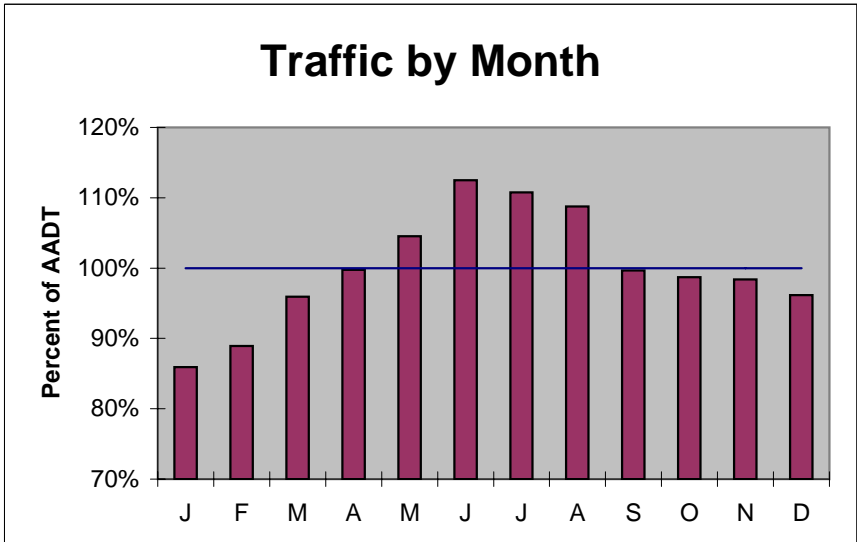
Data from 32 locations provided by the Traffic Systems Center in Northeastern Illinois from 2004-2006 were used to determine these travel patterns.

AADT - Annual Average Daily Traffic

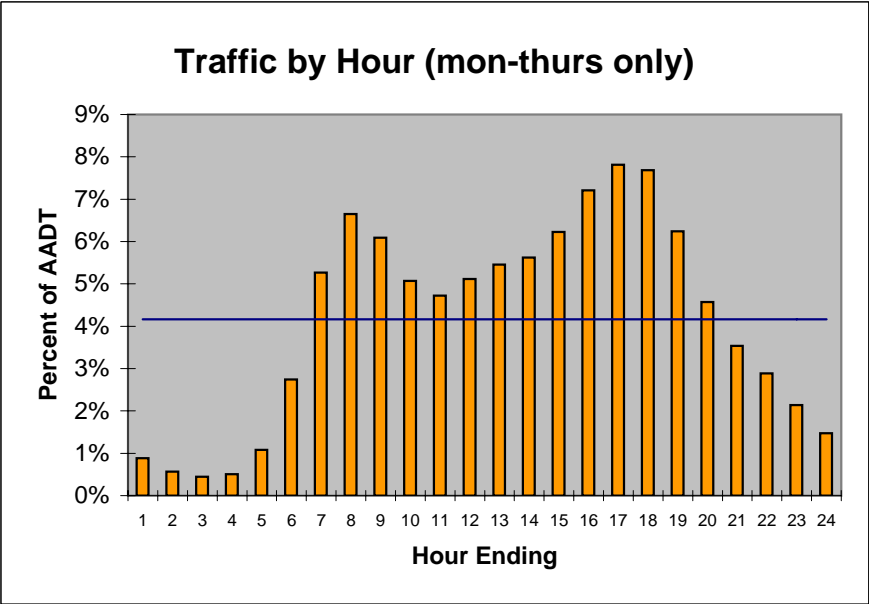
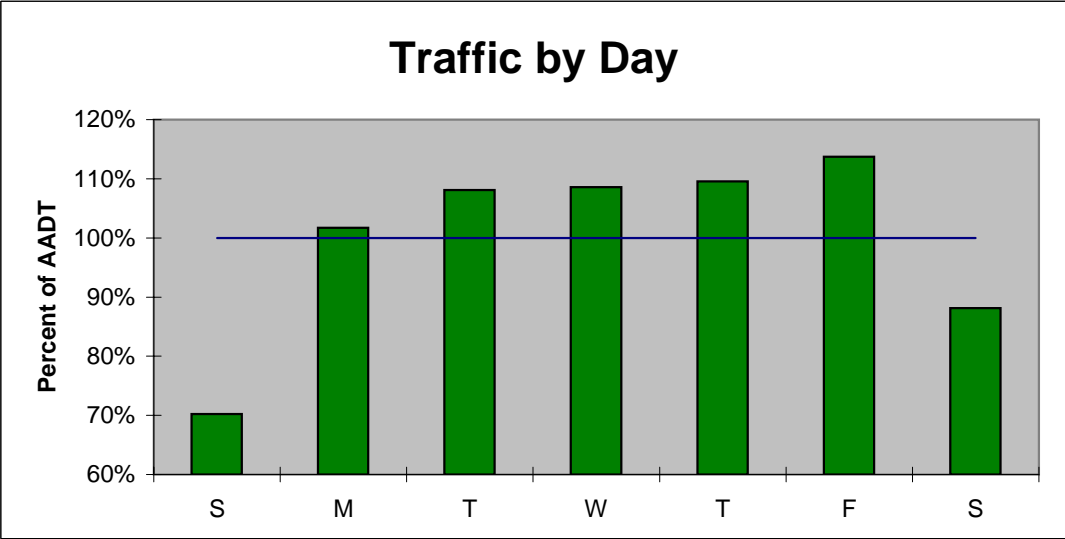
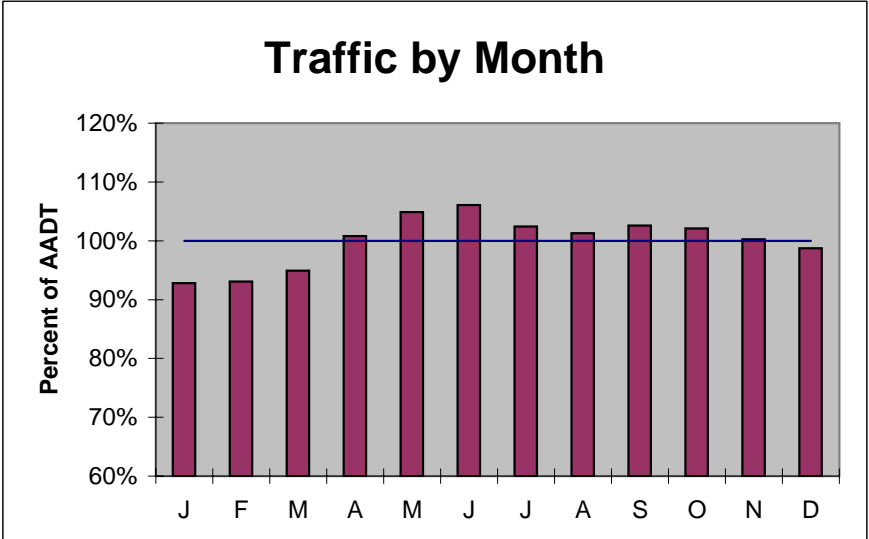

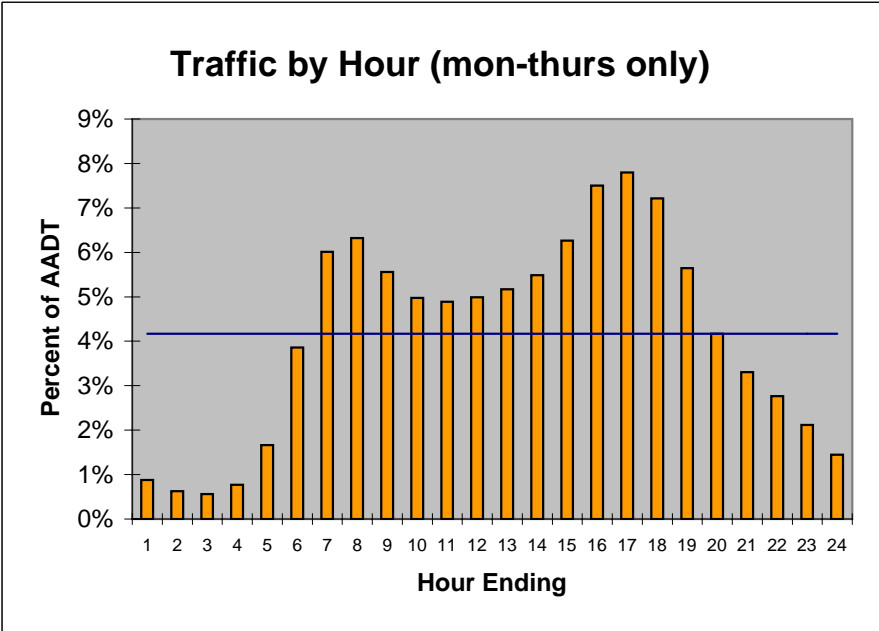
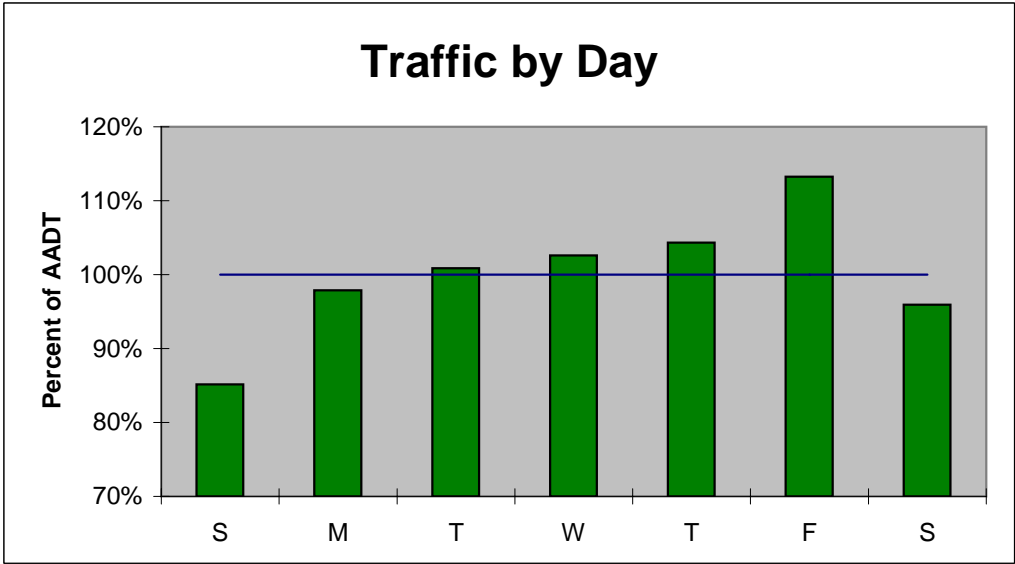

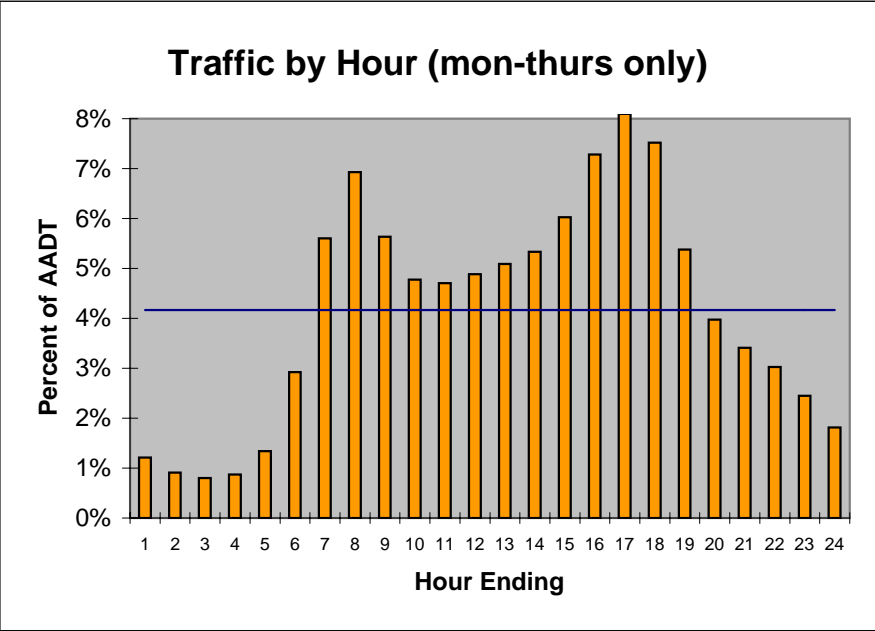
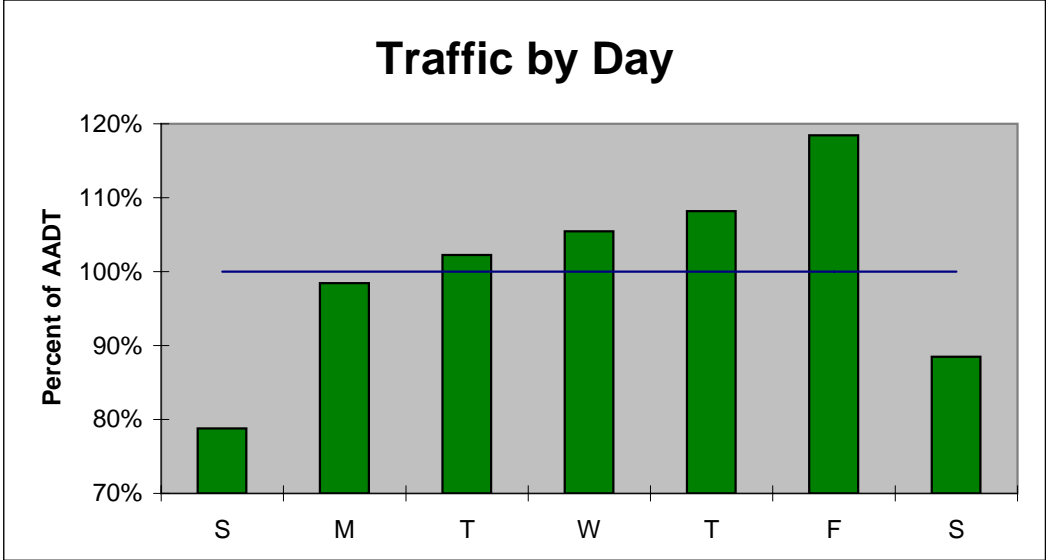
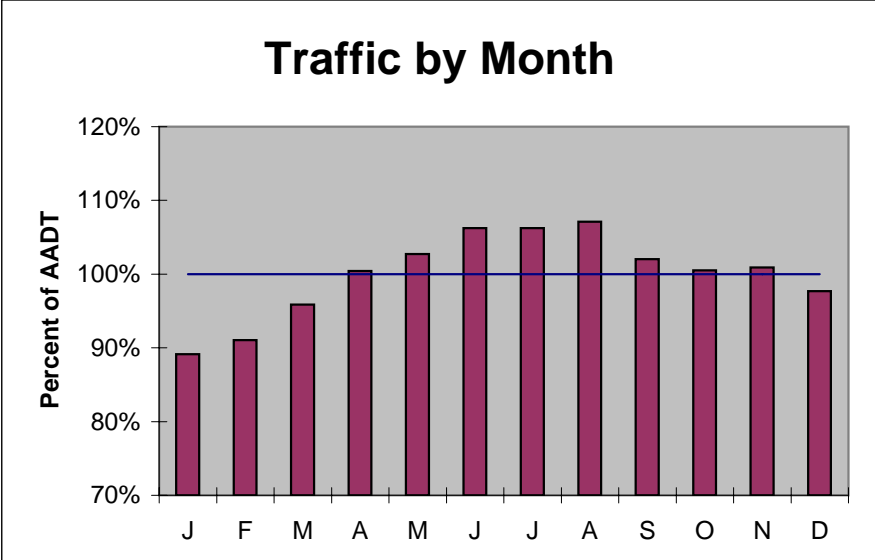

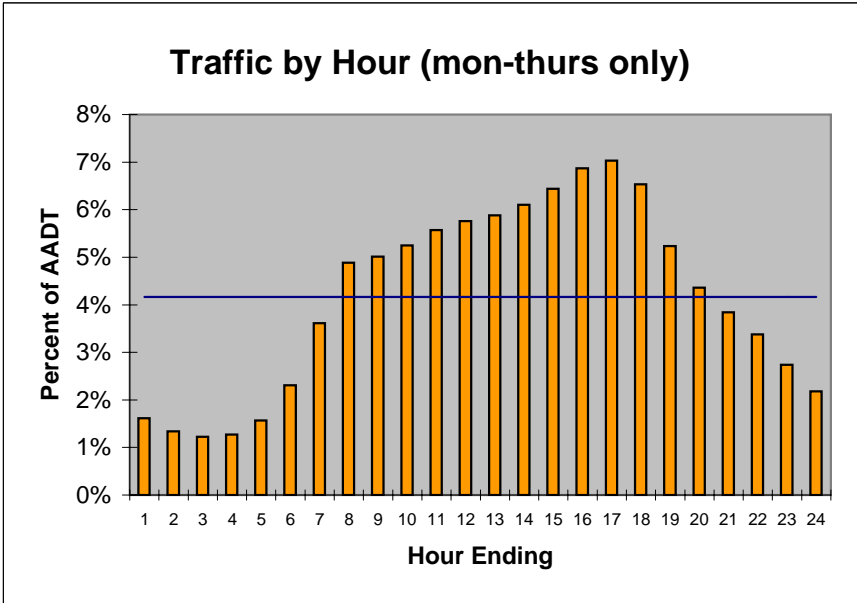
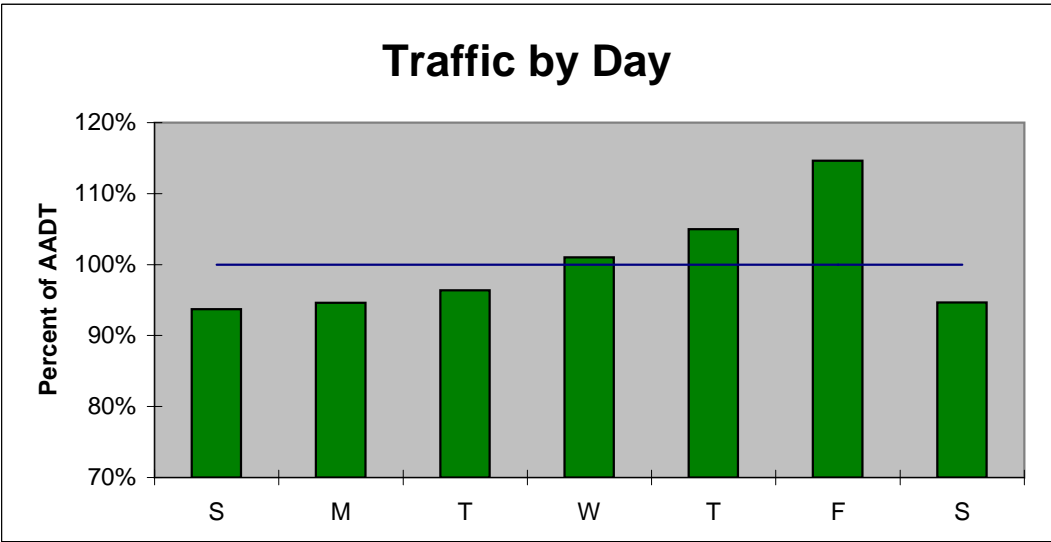
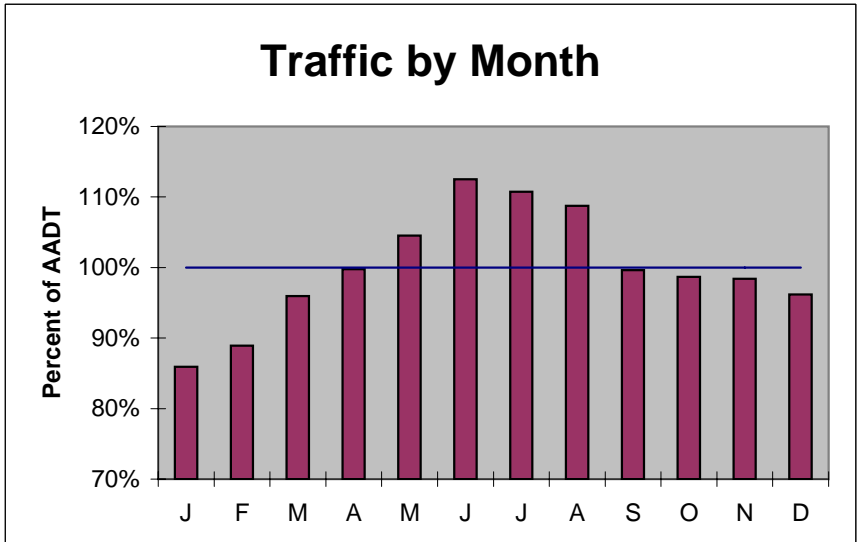

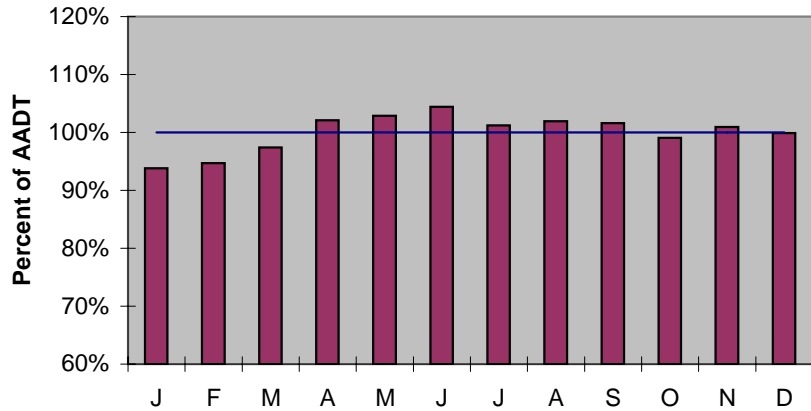

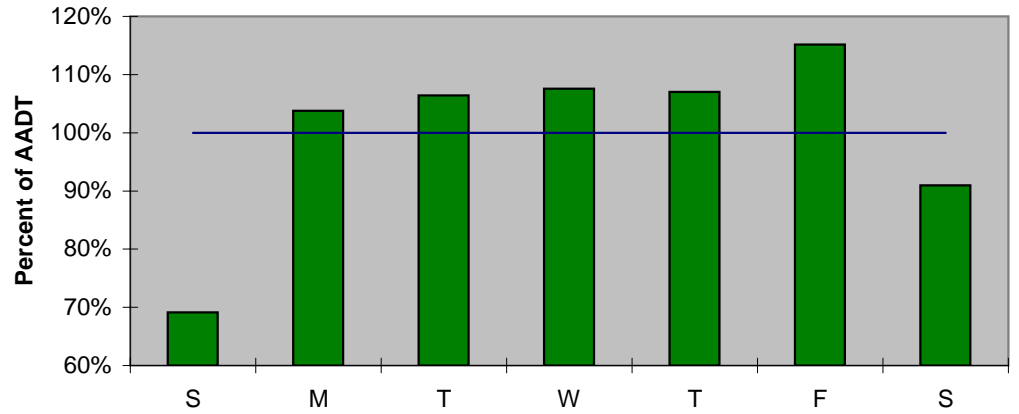

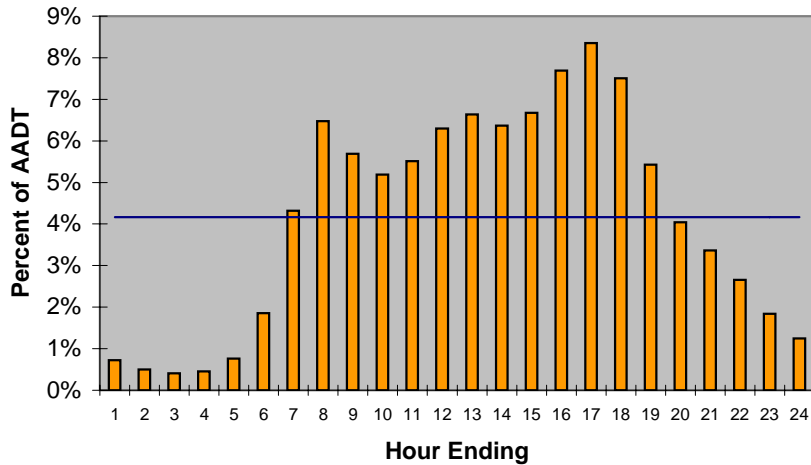
### Traffic by Month

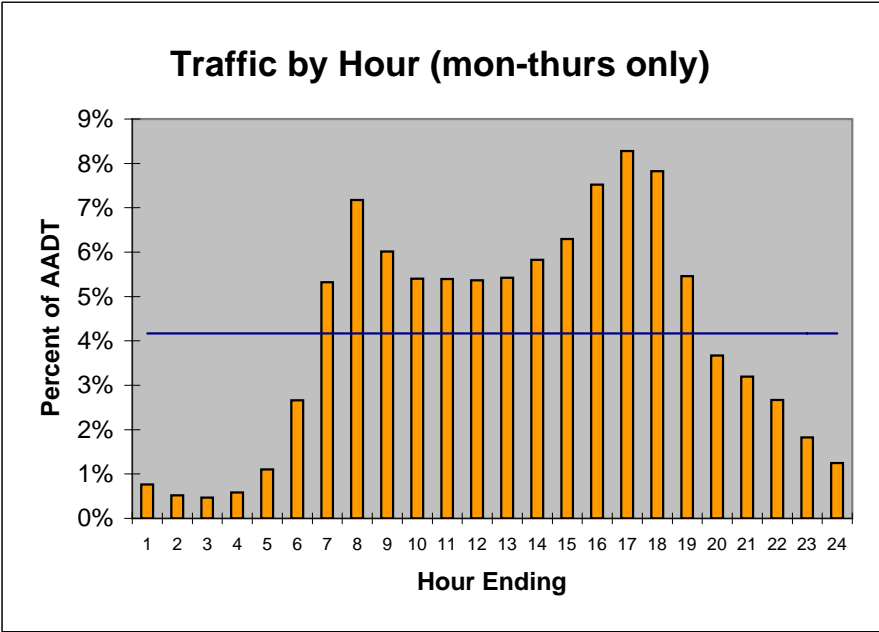
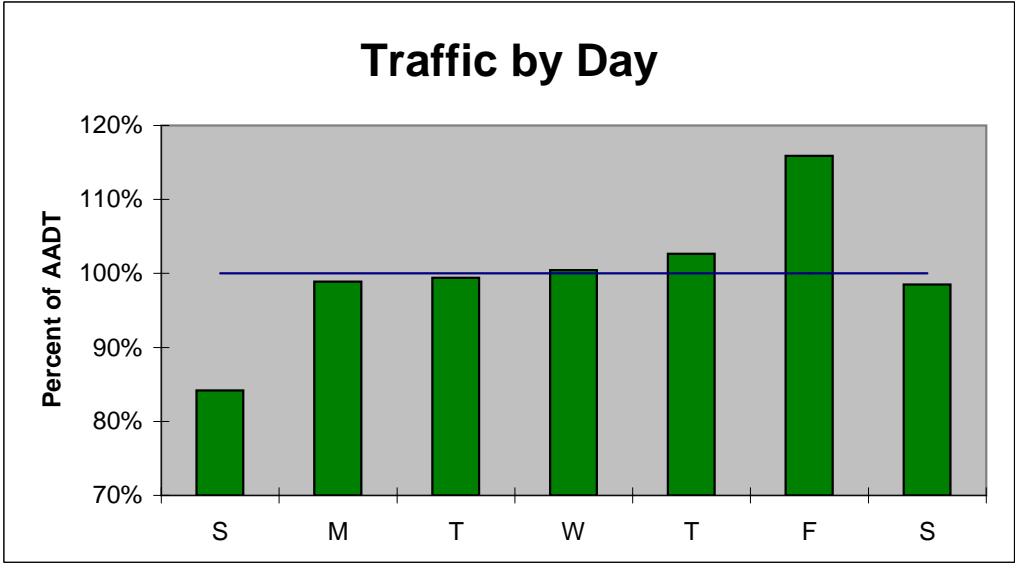
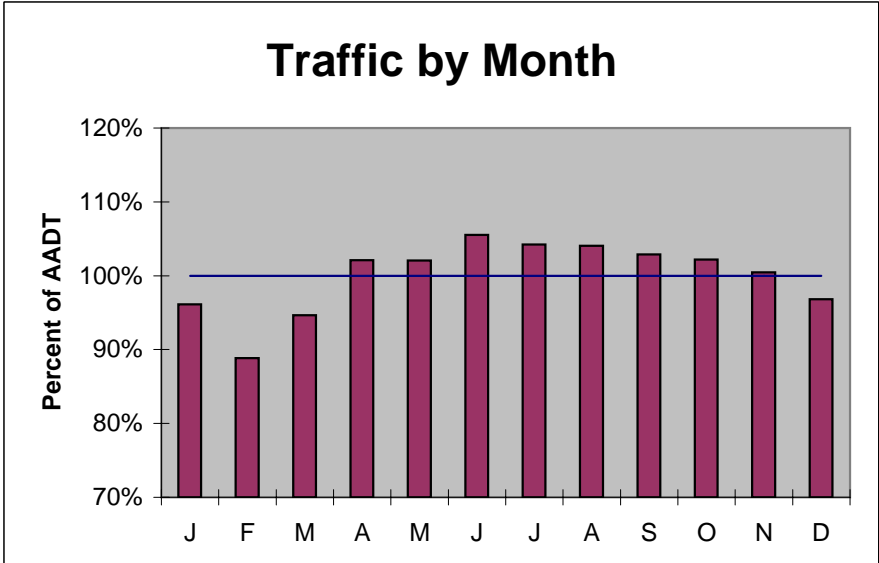
