

Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) Rebuilding and Widening Project



By the Numbers

The Illinois Tollway has committed \$2.2 billion to rebuild and widen the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) as a 21st century, state-of-the-art corridor linking Rockford to O'Hare International Airport. The Jane Addams Memorial Tollway is part of Interstate 90, the longest interstate in the United States.

I-90 REBUILDING AND WIDENING PROJECT

- Total miles - 62 today
- Lane miles - 294 today, 418 in 2016
- Bridges replaced or rehabilitated - 109
- Interchanges - 15 today, 16+ in 2016

TRANSIT

- New Park & Ride locations - 3
- Parking spaces - as many as 450
- New Pace bus routes - 4
- Expanded Pace bus routes - 2

STATE-OF-THE-ART FEATURES

- Dynamic Message Signs - 7 today, up to 36 in 2016
- Traffic Sensors - 40 today, up to 95 in 2016
- Roadway Cameras - 45 today, up to 88 in 2016
- Conduit - up to 344 miles in 2016

TRAFFIC

- 317,000 daily vehicles today, estimated 400,000 daily vehicles in 2016
- Passenger vehicles - 282,000 today, estimated 360,000 in 2016
- Trucks - 35,000 today, estimated 40,000 in 2016

JOBS

- 11,500 additional permanent jobs within the Chicago region
- 23,900 total jobs during construction

- Counties served - 5
- Communities served - 16 directly impacted
