***RESOLUTION 95-1***

**CERTIFICATION of the 1995 PARATRANSIT  
PLAN UPDATES of RMTD and LPTS**

WHEREAS the Rockford Area Transportation Study (RATS) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Rockford Metropolitan Area and said organization, governed by the RATS Policy Committee, has the responsibility to direct, coordinate and administer the transportation planning process in the area; and


WHEREAS Section 223 of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as implemented by 49 CFR, Part 37 requires that the Rockford Mass Transit District (RMTD) and the Loves Park Transit System (LPTS) [1] develop paratransit services comparable and complementary to their fixed route services, [2] develop Paratransit Plans to fully comply with the above, and [3] update said plans on an annual basis; and


WHEREAS RATS has reviewed the 1995 Paratransit Plan Updates of both RMTD and LPTS and has found these Updates to be [1] improvements to the previous Paratransit Plans, [2] in conformance with adopted areawide transportation plans, as developed under 49 CFR Part 613 and 23 CFR Part 450 (the FTA-FHWA joint plan regulation), and [3] in conformance with the ADA and related laws; NOW, THEREFORE BE IT




