ROCKFORD AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY**

RESOLUTION 96-12

RE: ADOPTION OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ROCKFORD AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY POLICY COMMITTEE AND THE CITY OF LOVES PARK, CITY OF ROCKFORD AND WINNEBAGO COUNTY FOR THE CONDUCTING OF A CONGESTION MANAGEMENT STUDY OF EAST RIVERSIDE BOULEVARD, FOREST HILLS ROAD, AND ALPINE ROAD

WHEREAS the Rockford Area Transportation Study (RATS) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Rockford Metropolitan Area, and the Policy Committee has the specific responsibility to direct and administer the continuing transportation planning process; and

WHEREAS on June 26, 1996, the Policy Committee adopted RATS Resolutions 96-8, which adopted the RATS Unified Work Program for FY97; and

WHEREAS on June 26, 1996, the Policy Committee adopted RATS Resolutions 96-9, which amended the FY97 RATS Unified Work Program for conducting a Congestion Management Study for the Riverside Boulevard Corridor and the allocation of \$40,000 in RATS "PL funds" and \$10,000 in local funds (one third each from Loves Park, Rockford and Winnebago County); and

WHEREAS Winnebago County Highway Department was identified as the local lead agency for the Riverside Boulevard Corridor Congestion Management Study; and

WHEREAS an "Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement Between The County Of Winnebago, The City Of Rockford, The City Of Loves Park And The Rockford Area Transportation Study For The Conducting Of A Congestion Management Study Of East Riverside Boulevard, Forest Hills Road and Alpine Road" has been prepared which explains the terms of the agreement; and

WHEREAS the Agreement has been reviewed by the Rockford Area Transportation Study Policy Committee and said Committee agrees with the terms of the agreement: **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT**

RESOLVED that the Rockford Area Transportation Study Policy Committee adopts the Agreement: **AND, BE IT FURTHER**






