2.1 Illinois Department of Transportation, District 2 - LONG: IL 2 (South Main Street) Intersection at Clifton Avenue, on schedule, 11%, still on stage one.

IL 173 and I-90, on schedule, 76%.

I think we have a few others, that we're gonna have a precon early next week coming up. We should be getting a start on a bunch of others in May.

ERNST: You don't have a tentative ribbon cutting / opening date for IL 173 interchange, do you?

LONG: Right now, our schedule says the end of June is when we're gonna be complete. So, I was just talking today with our field engineer about that. He seems to think that we're gonna have to have something special going on out there.

ERNST: I would imagine...most...gotta have a ribbon cutting of some kind, grand opening.

LONG: In the next couple weeks I think they're gonna get on that and start finding out what's what with that.

So, I'll keep you updated on that.

2.2 Winnebago County Highway Department – VLK: We'll have our Belvidere Road Resurfacing Project starting up early June.

Next week we'll be starting our Temporary Signal Project on Ralsted on Bluebonnett west of 251.

April 30 letting for our Willowbrook / Perryville Intersection Improvement.

Our other major projects will be probably starting up late June.

So, I'll just reiterate them next month.

2.3 City of Rockford, Public Works Department – ZUROSKE: The Harrison Avenue Ohio Pkwy to Mulford Project continues.

We have switched over to the northern lanes.

I would say the project's probably somewhere in the 40% complete range.

We still, obviously, have medians to do and a whole variety of other things, but that project is well underway.

The Harrison Avenue Lighting and Landscaping Project, in conjunction with this, we have completed the plans and submitted them to IDOT.

We're waiting back for any comments.

We would expect that to be on the letting sometime, I think they're shooting for the June letting.

Ultimately, for that to be done in early 2008.

The Harrison Avenue Phase 2 portion, which is 20th to 11th, we have completed our right-of-way investigation and submitted the plans to IDOT.

We would expect to move that project along a little bit more aggressively over the next year or so.

But we've done our work and IDOT's doing the information, there.

Harrison Avenue Bridges that is for the CN & UP, almost adjacent to Flynn Middle School.

That project has been let.

The preconstruction meeting has been completed,

We would expect construction to start there sometime in the next 30-60 days.

The two-phased construction, obviously, we've got to keep one set of bridges open.

We would expect that to really get kicked off in late May, early June.

That will be under construction this year.

The Main Street & Auburn Roundabout, we're in engineering.

We're working with Hanson Engineers, there,

We have been chipping away at some of the IDOT requirements.

We're scheduled to do IDOT's bi-monthly meeting, hopefully sometime even later this month, in the next few weeks.

But, we've made a lot of progress there.

Our Whitewater Feasibility Study, for anybody who's interested, is kicked off about four or five months ago.

We did do a dam assessment.

We did a draw down of the Rock River

We did a complete dam inspection.

We've been trading information with IDNR, and IEPA, and others.

We would expect to at least have some sort of deliverable in the way of a feasibility analysis sometime in mid-summer.

But we are moving on that fairly quickly.

We are also in the process of finalizing our North Main Street Street Corridor Plan.

We'll be meeting with the consultants over next couple of months, but we look to have that completed.
